This document contains shortlist score data for PHST medical oncology recruitment. Graphs depicting the distribution of shortlisting scores are presented for both rounds 1 & 2.




## PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2025 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores (verified self-assessment) awarded to medical oncology applications which reached the evidence verification stage in 2025 PHST recruitment round 1.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 190; shortlist scores ranged from 8-59 (min and max possible were 0-60).

Mean and median averages achieved were **36** (35.5) and **36** respectively.






## PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2024 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores (verified self assessment) awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2024 PHST recruitment round

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 252; shortlist scores ranged from 0-66 (min and max possible were 0-70).

Mean and median averages achieved were 37 (37.3) and 38 respectively.






## PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2023 (round 2)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores (verified self assessment) awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2023 PHST recruitment round 2.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 50; shortlist scores ranged from 23-61 (min and max possible were 0-70).

Mean and median averages achieved were 40 (39.4) and 37.5 respectively.






## PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2023 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores (verified self assessment) awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2023 PHST recruitment round

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 148; shortlist scores ranged from 0-65 (min and max possible were 0-70).

Mean and median averages achieved were 40 (39.8) and 40.5 respectively.






# PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2022 (round 2)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores(verified self assessment) awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2022 PHST recruitment round 2.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 46; shortlist scores ranged from 0-54 (min and max possible were 0-78).

Mean and median averages achieved were 22 (21.67) and 23 respectively.






## PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2022 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores(verified self assessment) awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2022 PHST recruitment round 1.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 174; shortlist scores ranged from 10-75 (min and max possible were 0-78).

Mean and median averages achieved were 40 (39.51) and 39 respectively.






# PHST medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2021 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores(verified self assessment) awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2022 PHST recruitment round 1.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 195; shortlist scores ranged from 8-50 (min and max possible were 0-78).

Mean and median averages achieved were 26 (25.85) and 25 respectively.






## ST3 medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2020 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2020 ST3 recruitment round 1.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 182; shortlist scores ranged from 5-80 (min and max possible were 0-80).

Mean and median averages achieved were 44 (44.16) and 45 respectively.






## ST3 medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2019 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2019 ST3 recruitment round 1.

The number of applications progressing to shortlisting was 143; shortlist scores ranged from 12-67 (min and max possible were 0-80).

Mean and median averages achieved were 41 (40.91) and 41 respectively.






## ST3 medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2018 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2018 ST3 recruitment round 1.

The number of applications submitted was 117; shortlist scores ranged from 7-70 (min and max possible were 0-80).

Mean and median averages achieved were 43 (43.11) and 44 respectively.






## ST3 medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2017 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2017 ST3 recruitment round 1.

The number of applications submitted was 111; shortlist scores ranged from 11-72 (min and max possible were 0-78).

Mean and median averages achieved were 43 (43.37) and 42 respectively.






## ST3 medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2016 (round 1)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2016 ST3 recruitment round 1.

The number of applications submitted was 122; shortlist scores ranged from 11-68 (min and max possible were 0-78).

Mean and median averages achieved were 41 (41.25) and 42 respectively.





## ST3 medical oncology recruitment – shortlist score distribution 2016 (round 2)

The graph below shows the distribution of shortlist scores awarded to all medical oncology applications submitted in 2016 ST3 Recruitment round 2.

The number of applications submitted was 17; shortlist scores ranged from 18-63 (min and max possible were 0-78).

Mean and median averages achieved were 42 (42.05) and 45 respectively.
